

DIGITAL MEDIA CHECKLIST

1. RELEVANCE & ACCURACY

- Is the content relevant to at least one learning objective?
- Is the content accurate and up to date?
- Is the content produced by a reputable source?
- Is content written at an appropriate level for the intended audience?
- Is the design appealing & clear?
- If there are interactive elements, are the controls intuitive & the activities contribute to learning?
- Are there opportunities for learner self-assessment?

2. ACCESSIBILITY

- Are elements formatted with sufficient contrast?
- Do images have alt-text?
- If applicable, is audio of high quality?
- If applicable, do videos have captions?
- If applicable, is the resource available in alternative formats?
- Is the resource compatible with the learning platform (e.g., hosting, embedding, etc.)?

3. LICENSING

- Is the resource under copyright?
- If applicable, does the license permit Educational Reuse of the resource?
- If applicable, does the license permit adaptation or modification of the content/materials?
